





In 2012, permits for 6 267 m³ of Kiaat timber were issued by Bagani DoF. This means about 17 000 Kiaat trees were harvested. 100% of this was from Angola and most (95%) of this timber was destined for South Africa.

In 2014, permits for 2 183 m³ of Rosewood timber were issued by Katima Mulilo DoF. 99% of this was from Zambia and most (86%) of this timber was destined for China.

In 2011, permits for 2 845 m³ of Zambezi Teak timber were issued by Katima Mulilo DoF. 66% of this was from Zambia and most (58%) of this timber was destined for South Africa.
